



# **Foundation News**


Stanley Music Endowment Fund Makes Its Initial Distribution

In 2009, Charles and Marilyn Stanley established a new account within the Western Hills UMC Foundation to create a permanent endowment to aid in the needs of the church music program. The principle of the Fund is to be held permanently, with distributions from earnings to be made in accordance with criteria prescribed by the Stanleys. A cash donation from the Stanleys started the fund, and a large gift from the estate of Charles Stanley, plus numerous memorials in the memory of Charles Stanley provided the bulk of the Fund. The Fund was invested with the New Mexico Conference Methodist Foundation and is administered by the Western Hills UMC Foundation. As of September 30, 2014, the market value of the fund was \$48,739.98.




In the fall of 2014, the music department requested funds for the purchase of new choir robes. On December 16, 2014 a distribution in the amount of \$4,837.00 was made to pay for the new choir robes. This was the first such distribution made from the Stanley Music Endowment.

Interested persons may designate gifts to the Fund, in order that it might grow and provide resources to further worship through music.
