HYMNS OF "SOCIAL HOLINESS"

We are called individually to be holy. We are also called, as a people of God, to be collectively holy. In our current hymnal there is an entire section devoted to "social holiness". Most of these hymns are set to more traditional tunes you are probably familiar with but others are relatively new, that is, written in the early to mid 20th century. The lyrics of many of these also reflect our changing society and our response to it as holy people.



During the next several weeks while Robert's sermons will be emphasizing our role as Christians in a societal world, our hymns will also call us to "social holiness".

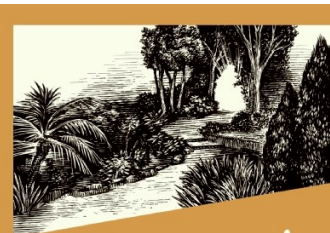

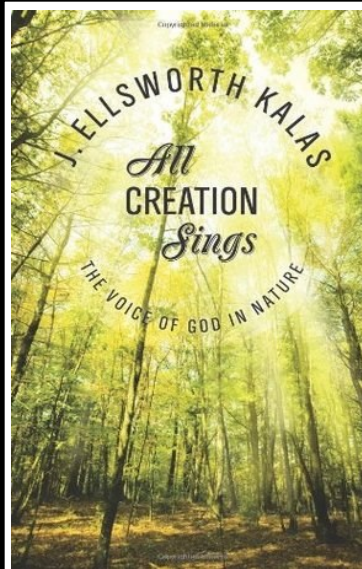

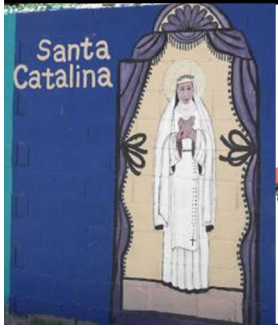

NEWS FROM WESTERN HILLS ACADEMY

*Beginning its 51st year of operation
on the campus of Western Hills UMC.*

The first day of the 2015-16 school year for Western Hills Academy is August 24. Registration is ongoing in room C-1. Begun in 1965 as a community outreach, the program now includes a Mother's Day Out for ages 1-3 and a school for PK through fifth grade.

Among the most significant changes are the purchasing of new pea gravel on the upper playground, a new fire alarm system in Buildings B and C, and upgraded internet cabling for new computers in Buildings B and C. As a result of inspections, the school is in good standing with the Texas Department of Family and Protective Services.
