There is SO much you can do! Remember to stop and thank God for all His blessings!











We have a unique opportunity to assist in KAIROS weekend #2 (Dec. 3-7, 2015) at the

Otero County Prison.

And when was it that we saw you sick or in prison and visited you?

Matthew 25:39

These are just a few of the ways you can help God's love transform lives:

- MAKE PLACEMATS Our Children's Ministry will be coloring placemats in Sunday School/Children's Church so that the team members and residents know they are loved. Children will draw/color a picture and write their first name (only) and age on the placemat.
- PRAY that God's love works in the lives of the team and residents.
- DONATIONS towards the cost of meals gratefully accepted.
- BE A PART OF THE OUTSIDE PREP TEAM (Dec. 3 or 4)
- BAKE COOKIES: There will be boxes labelled KAIROS in the narthex and office for the drop off between November 22 and November 29. Each resident in the prison will receive at least one dozen cookies.

Cookie Guidelines: (no powdered sugar, nuts, or dried fruits) Chocolate Chip, Sugar, Creamy Peanut Butter cookies are favorites. 2 1/2-3" cookies so that 12 cookies (4 stacks of 3 cookies each) fit in a quart size freezer Ziploc bag.
