




















NEWS FROM THE Children's th Ministry


VIEWS FROM THE RIDGE

Western Hills Academy Applying for Accreditation

This Fall, Western Hills Academy is taking the initial step in applying for accreditation with the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools. SACS is a division of AdvancED, "the world's largest education community, serving public and private schools and colleges across the US and in more than 70 countries." The application and a Readiness Report were submitted in November, and a preliminary visit by a representative from the State Office is scheduled for December 11. If the report is favorable, the school will be considered to be a candidate for accreditation. Then a more detailed report comparing the school to the Standards will be submitted and a team representing the State will visit, perhaps in 2016-17.

Achieving accreditation will allow WHA to be a member with 40 other schools in the city, public and private, large and small. Such schools have opened themselves to the scrutiny of other educators, demonstrating their determination to continually improve.

The school is soliciting contributions to pay for the \$1,600 application fees. Donations should be in the name of Western Hills Academy and turned in to the Director, Patricia Aguirre, in the school's office, Room C-1 in C-Building.
