Disciple 1 Becoming Disciples Through Bible Study

Orientation Meeting Sept 8th

A 34 week overview of the entire Bible from Genesis to Revelation. Video teachings, group discussions, weekly and daily Scripture readings form the basis of this in-depth Bible study. 

Early in 2015, as a result of a periodic inspection of Buildings B and C of the church campus, regarding state licensing standards for Child Care facilities and the City of El Paso Fire Department, church Trustees were notified that immediate action had to be taken to install a fire alarm system together with exit/egress lighting in both buildings. Failure to comply in a timely manner with these requirements would have resulted in the closure of the buildings.

Funding for these installations had not been budgeted, nor were there other funds available to cover these expenses. The Trustees turned to the WHUMC Foundation for assistance, and the Directors of the Foundation promptly approved the advance



of funds to cover these expenses. In the ensuing days and weeks, the Foundation paid \$6,145 for the installation of 18 exit/egress lights, and \$21,011 for the fire alarm system. This is a typical occurrence of the types of help for which the Foundation is available.

We are blessed at Western Hills to have the Foundation to further our ministries. Please remember there is no gift too large or too small.
