"Initially we were told that DISCIPLE Bible study was going to be transforming. Indeed. At the end we find ourselves on a different road. Before I began DISCIPLE, it was invisible, hearing but not understanding, seeing but never perceiving. It is disconcerting, after months of enormously exciting Bible study, to find yourself on a new road. Sunday has become Sabbath, church has become worship, communion has become covenant, and people have become bonded. Now being on this road, you cannot leave it. You cannot stand still on it, you can rest, but you cannot stand still. It is a "way", it is a journey, and it is life. If I never see you again, no matter, you will be with me always. And if I know with certainty that you will be with me always, then how much more so will Christ. My DISCIPLE family, have been "little Christs" to me, have been answered prayers for me and I thank you."

My greatest joy in ministry has been realized as I have witnessed others respond to the call of God in their lives, as parents, as leaders, as advocates for those with special needs and to ministries of all kinds. I have been honored to have spent time "in the Word" with many fellow pilgrims. Some are now part of the Church Triumphant and some have moved to other states and led Disciple groups there.

The rewards are incredible for those of you who commit to be leaders also — you will grow in your faith and be blessed as you witness the transformation in others. God lets us see others transformed — not so that we can feel pride or take credit for the growth — but <u>only</u> so that we might see His mighty power at work, and give Him the glory. The effect this study has on your life will not be contained — it will be felt by all of those around you. Trust God on this. I have seen it happen, time and time again.







MARK YOUR CALENDARS Neighborhood Trunk or Treat October 29th


We need lots of helpers and decorated trunks for this year's trunk or treat fall celebration.
