### VIEWS FROM THE RIDGE

Josh's Jottings...

I am writing with exciting news and with a plea for your help. In her book, <u>Help, Thanks, Wow: The Three Essential Prayers</u>, Anne Lamott offers some advice, which all of us at The Ridge will be challenged to follow in the months ahead. Lamott writes:

When we think we can do it all ourselves – fix, save, buy, or date a nice solution – it's hopeless. We're going to screw things up. We're going to get our tentacles wrapped around things and squirt our squiddy ink all over, so that there is even less visibility, and then we're going to squeeze the very life out of everything...Or we can summon up a child's courage and [say a few small words of prayer] in the hope that we can get our inky squid tentacles off things. We do this without a clue how it will all turn out.

Looking at the year ahead, Lamott's words ring true. In October, I formed a group that would explore "New Directions" that our congregation can explore as we grow our witness and ministry to our neighbors in far west El Paso. Over the last few months, the New Directions team has discerned that we want to explore the possibility of locating a dedicated meeting space for our little congregation. This would mean moving our meeting place from Brown Middle School to a location where we could worship, meet, and reach out to the community throughout the week. (No set-up and tear-down every week. A space for family ministries, discipleship, community outreach. Yay!)

To be sure, this goal is not a sure thing yet. We need to find a location that is both financially reasonable and in a location and facility that is suitable to our missional needs. To borrow Lamott's words, we are doing this "without a clue how it will turn out." So I want to invite all of you at both The Ridge and Western Hills to please join me in praying for The Ridge as we explore this process. Wherever our congregation meets, we want to continually pursue the next faithful steps in God's plan for us. This can be unnerving and requires we follow in faith and prayer. Also, mark your calendars for January 13-14 when we will hold a 24-hour prayer vigil for The Ridge. We'll be sharing more about this event in the weeks to come. But we want to explore these new directions in an attitude of prayerful obedience.
