VIEWS FROM THE RIDGE

Dear Friends at The Ridge and Western Hills,

As you may have heard by now, this June I will be reappointed to Mesa View United Methodist Church in Albuquerque. As you can imagine, reappointment is a bittersweet event for most pastors. On the one hand, it is exciting to begin a new chapter and I know that good things await me. At the same time, I realize that I am leaving behind something good as well.

I am so grateful for the last three years at The Ridge and Western Hills. I am grateful for the time shared with you all, worshipping and praising God, for your partnership in meeting the challenges that have come up along the way, and for all the things I've learned about ministry, faith, and life through my time at the Ridge.
