#### Pastor John shares a little about bis mission work in Africa...

The Congo Projects For Relief (CPR) organization is pursuing a Clean Water Project for the Village of Musumba in the Kapanga District of the Katanga Province of the Democratic Republic of the Congo. We are working in conjunction with the Musumba Water Committee, the Mwant-Yav Tribal Chief, the Government of Katanga Province, the Catholic Church, and the United Methodist Church, all of whom are significant stakeholders in providing clean water to the Village. Our goal is to create a village water utility that will be self-sustaining.

The Village of Musumba currently has a resident population of approximately 45,000 inhabitants. There is insufficient clean water for the local population which continues to grow and is projected to approach 60,000

inhabitants within a few years. Clean water is critical to the health and welfare of the people in Musumba.

Our team has made 8 trips to Musumba. We have drilled a well

150 feet deep, installed a high volume electric well pump and erected a 500,000 liter storage tank. We are working with the villagers to improve distribution and organize a water committee. Our next trip is scheduled for September 2019.

## CHURCH WIDE SUNDAY SCHOOL STUDY – THIS JULY





(From Lewis Center for Church Leadership)

- 1. Open your hearts and decide that you are going to love your new pastor.
- 2. Begin praying daily for the new pastor and family, even as you continue to pray for your departing pastor and family.
- 3. Invite church members individually to send cards of welcome and encouragement to the incoming pastor.
- 4. Know that welcoming your new pastor in genuine and effective ways lays the ground work for a healthy and vital relationship and the development of stable, long-term ministries together.
- 5. Plan for the transition. Occasionally important welcoming gestures are missed with everyone thinking someone else is handling these details.
- 6. Appoint a specific liaison person to whom the pastor can go for help and information during the transition.




#### THIS IS EXCITING NEWS – our vision for the Sobremesa food truck ministry is being realized.

Bravo to every person who cooked, shopped, cleaned, served, washed dishes, scrubbed and took out the trash!

#### We've done four major events in less than 8 weeks...WOWZA!

- We served breakfast at the Annual UMW District Meeting April 6<sup>th</sup> breakfast burritos and fresh fruit, juice and coffee – for 75 ladies and men.
- Next was the BIG undertaking Youth Mystery Dinner Theatre where we provided a gourmet meal for about 200 folks on April 12 and 13
- Then the May 19th Senior Breakfast (for 15-20) this past Sunday it looked exquisite.
- And we participated in a multi-agency collaboration on Wed., May 22 that was attempting to assess and identify the unknown homeless on the streets by providing both breakfast and lunch/dinner meals for 150 people.

We did this while still serving 125-150 people at the Opportunity Center, as we usually do, with two evening





provide weekly. We also trained a whole new cadre of certified food handlers -

on April 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup>, including some youth! You all have done incredible work! We received \$2200 in profits from the dinner theatre (\$2500 went to the Youth Mission Trip) and will receive a donation of \$200 for the Senior Breakfast meal. We can feed a lot of hungry people with the money we made from these two events. This vision is now reality. Well done!!!

Thank you for your dedicated humble service and ingenuity – it's happening because we are living out our mission statement "BELONG,
