Justice For Our Neighbors (JFON)

Justice For Our Neighbors (JFON)

- + is a national United Methodist ministry
- + was founded by UMCOR (United Methodist Committee on Relief)
- + is serving thousands of clients yearly at the 19 JFON sites in the US
- + is providing accurate information and reliable legal services for immigrants

The El Paso community experienced a tremendous surge of asylum seekers in the past year. Since this was not the first surge of immigrants in this community, we began to look for ways to create better systems and structures in order to respond more



effectively to care for our immigrant brothers and sisters. One of the ideas we are pursuing is to bring JFON to our region to help us provide accurate information about immigration law to our community.

Earlier this year, we established a task force to begin exploring if a JFON site was something needed in our community and if it would be possible to establish a site here in El Paso. Conversations with attorneys and non-profits informed us of an overwhelmed system and the need for assistance.

Our next big step is to establish a board of directors for our future JFON site. We need suggestions and volunteers for board members, for those people who have a passion and heart for immigrant ministry. After a board is established, we will work towards fundraising to be able to hire an attorney and begin offering legal services. It is my hope that we can begin offering services in Summer 2020.
