So much has changed in recent weeks. In March we planned to cook and deliver quarts of soup and dessert weekly to those folks in congregation (Soup's On) and at Westway who were sheltering in place. Following all CDC and health guidelines, we had a cook team of less than 10 people, numerous delivery teams and served more than 150 people (86 quarts!) on March 19th and 20th. With the "STAY HOME, STAY SAFE" order on March 21st - plans changed quickly. All of the food items we had purchased for the next two weeks of Soup's On were delivered to the

Opportunity Center for the vulnerable population seeking shelter there. Since that time, I've seen our congregation step forward to serve and participate in different meaningful ways. Sunday School leaders and small group leaders reached out to their members thru weekly emails, phone calls, and ZOOM meetings. Some folks started sewing fabric masks and surgical caps. Members checked on members (and their pastors.) Members checked on neighbors to make sure they had masks, to share food. Mitzi found new ways to be with the youth, Jenny mailed notes and activity pages to our littlest sheep and their families. Pastor Kim started a weekly Prayer Gathering on Wednesdays. Worship became a virtual experience. In April we had "Psalms for our Souls" - a virtual Bible study with 36 people in three groups - and individuals from Virginia and Maryland joined in.

What do the rest of May and June look like? I'm not sure, but I do know WE ARE STILL THE CHURCH. Thank you church! Paster Amy

VIEWS FROM THE RIDGE

My Brothers & Sisters in Christ,

As state and local governments begin to ease restrictions on the shelter in place orders that have blanketed most of the nation, churches are facing a new and very different normal as they consider how to expand their ministry offerings in what appears to be a long season of social distancing. The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) has published a new "Interim Guidance for Communities of Faith" that outlines precautions churches may need to take as coronavirus restrictions are eased. These guidances include continued use of virtual options for worship and meetings, gathering size limitations, continued use of face coverings, heightened sanitation requirements, discouraging the use of offering plates, pew pads, shared books like hymnals, and even choirs. The Ridge will be closely evaluating and monitoring the information provided by the CDC and our local city and State authorities and will make a determination later in the month of May as to when and in what capacity we will start to worship in our church space. As soon as the Leadership Team and I make those decisions, we will inform you. *This will be sometime the week after Memorial Day*. Blessings,


